Katikati Community Centre	30 Year Anniversary Weaving Project	Commission the creation of a woven piece of art made by the residents of Katikati to commemorate the centre's 30th anniversary	\$2,000
Katikati Community Centre	School Holiday Programme	A full time programme of activities in the school holidays for 5-14 year olds	\$3,000
Ngā Kākano Foundation	Ngā mahi toi ō ngā kaumatua	Develop and deliver weekly art workshops over 10 weeks for kaumatua and addiction clients to use creativity to support their wellbeing and mental health management, resulting in a community exhibition	\$4,000
Te Puke Māori Women's Welfare League	Ngā Pu Kōrero o Apopo ki Te Puke	Host a one day event to provide an opportunity for rangatahi (<18 years of age) to deliver speeches they have composed in te reo Māori on set topics, supported by their whanau and teachers	\$4,990
Western Bay Heritage Trust	Visitation by local hapu & museum to Waikato Museum	Film and create videos of an historic visit by local iwi, museum and council staff to Waikato Museum to see taonga uplifted from Western Bay, including some of international significance	\$3,800
Wright Rohde Theatre	Performing Art Camp	Host a four day performing arts camp for youth aged 9-18 years with nationally recognised tutors covering all aspects of performing arts and culminating in a performance	\$3,900
