

Pāpāmoa Sports & Recreation Centre Mural

Call-out for Artists - information booklet

Project background and purpose:

To celebrate the 30th Birthday of the Pāpāmoa Sports and Recreation Centre, the venue's team are seeking expressions of interests from artists to paint a mural on the internal entrance wall.

Project brief:

We invite artists to send in an expression of interest to design a mural that celebrates Pāpāmoa, its people and landscape. Pāpāmoa is a haven for many, with a deep connection to mana whenua, the cultural and spiritual heart of Pāpāmoa is strong. The beach, pine trees, Mōtiti Island, Pāpāmoa Hills, schools, sports, parks, and clubs make Pāpāmoa a bustling and vibrant part of the Bay of Plenty that we want to celebrate.

We want artists to interpret the brief however they want, we're open to narratives, styles, and mediums (so long as they are 2D murals).

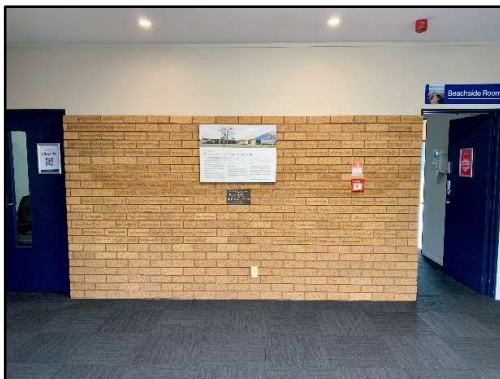
We encourage all artists to apply, but preference will be given to an artist with a connection to Pāpāmoa.

Ideally, the mural will be completed in September, ready to unveil during our 30th Birthday celebrations in mid-September 2024.

Location:

Pāpāmoa Sports & Recreation Centre is situated in Gordon Spratt Reserve, 80 Alice Way, Pāpāmoa.

The internal entrance wall has dimensions of 2600mm (H) X 3750mm (W).



Budget:

Pāpāmoa Sports and Recreation Centre is offering a \$5,000 fee for the mural (all inclusive), which includes both an artist fee and materials. The successful artist will need to provide all relevant materials for the completion of the work.

The venue will ensure that the wall is a 'blank canvas' and arrange for a clean plaster board base, by removing the current brickwork, electrical plug & fire call point (the costs for this will be incurred by the venue).

Application requirements:

To apply to be a mural artist, your application must include:

- A concept proposal (no more than one page)
- A brief timeline indicating how long you expect the installation of your mural to take, and ideal installation dates.
- A sketch
- A brief artist statement
- Your artist portfolio or links to your social media/website.

Friday 24th May – Applications open

Friday 28th June – Applications close

Friday 5th July – Artists notified of outcome

Installation dates of the mural will occur in consultation with the selected artists.
